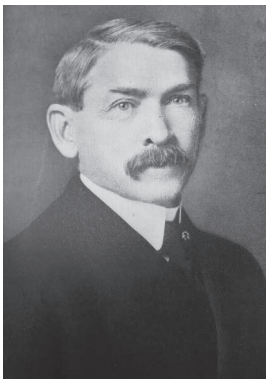

George W. Weadock was the first mayor of the consolidated Saginaws in 1891. He served two terms, working until Spring 1892. He is credited for adjusting the affairs of the two municipalities to the successful operation of one central government
